Why Open Access? ⁽¹⁾

- Greater visibility and impact;
- Research moves faster;
- Enables new semantic technologies.

Why Open Access? ⁽²⁾

- Do we want to continue to pay for subscriptions that get more and more expensive each year?
 - Electronic Databases + Journals in Luxembourg → 2 million / year
 - University spending → 1.4 million / year
 - Your institution → ???
- At some point, the money will run out (if it hasn't already!).

Why Open Access? ⁽³⁾

- Publishers' profit margins in 2014:

Profit	Company	Industry
10%	BMW	automobiles
23%	Rio Tinto	mining
25%	Google	search
29%	Apple	premium computing
35%	Springer	scholarly publishing
37%	Elsevier	scholarly publishing

Why Green (i.e. why a repository)?

- Provides a complete record of an institution's (or country's) scientific production;
- Publicises an institution's research strengths, providing maximum return on research investment;
- Works within the current copyright policies of commercial publishers;
- No favouritism – all disciplines equal.

Mandating Deposit



- Voluntary deposit \approx 15% of all publications
- Mandatory deposit \approx 60-90% of all publications

Mandating Deposit at UL

- What must be deposited?
 - Full-text electronic copies of all peer-reviewed journal articles and papers from published conference proceedings published since 1 Jan 2009 (while employed by the UL)
 - Bibliographic references of all scientific works published since 1 Jan 2009
 - Bibliographic details of your doctoral thesis (full-text if possible)
- When?
 - Immediately upon acceptance for publication

Mandating Deposit at UL

- Why?
 - Broaden dissemination, increase use and enhance visibility of our research;
 - Strengthen reputation of UL and its researchers in the international arena;
 - Increasing journal prices are prohibitive to scientific research → open up our work to those who cannot afford access;
 - Ensure a complete bibliographic reference of the University's entire scientific production.

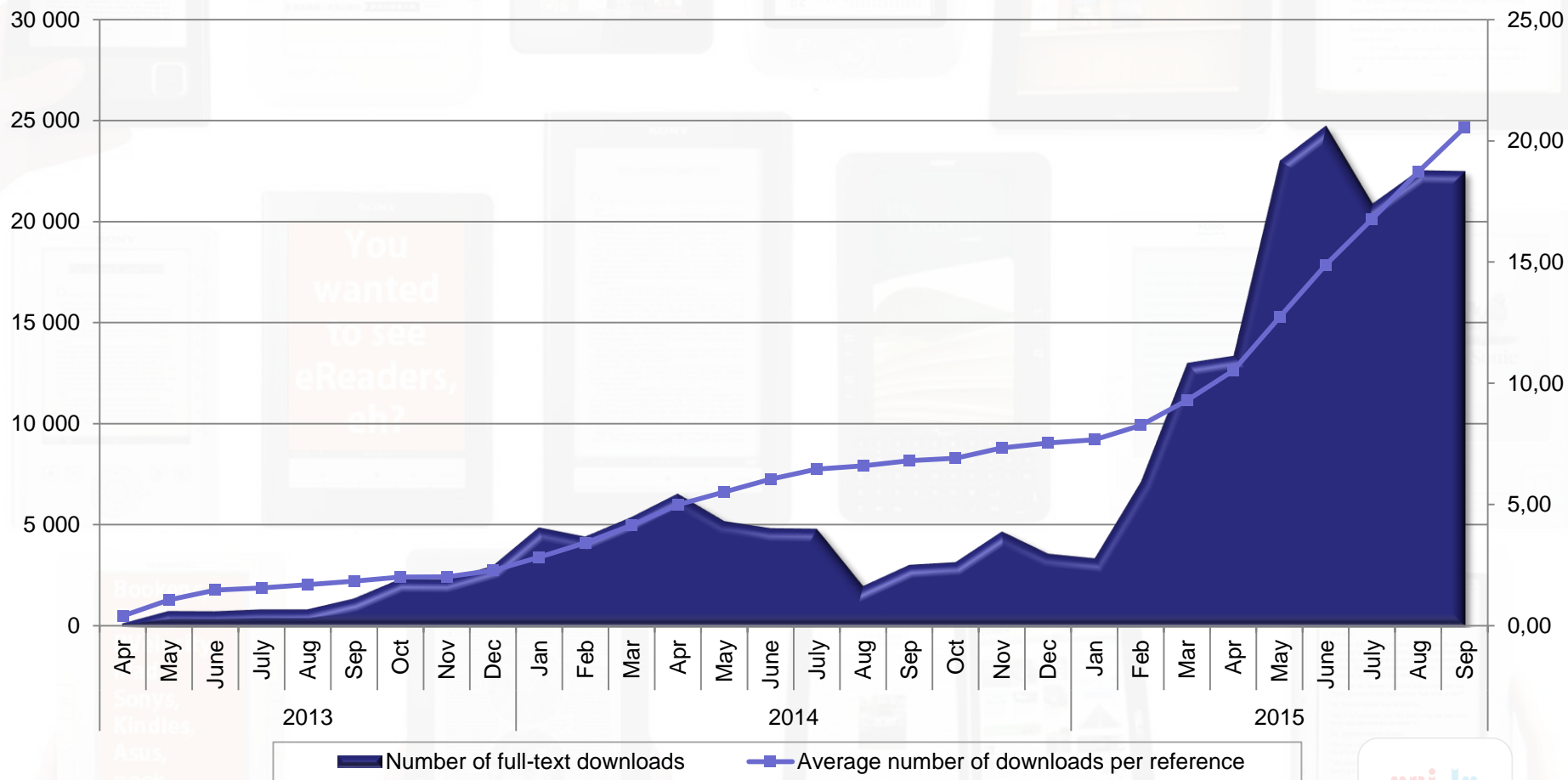

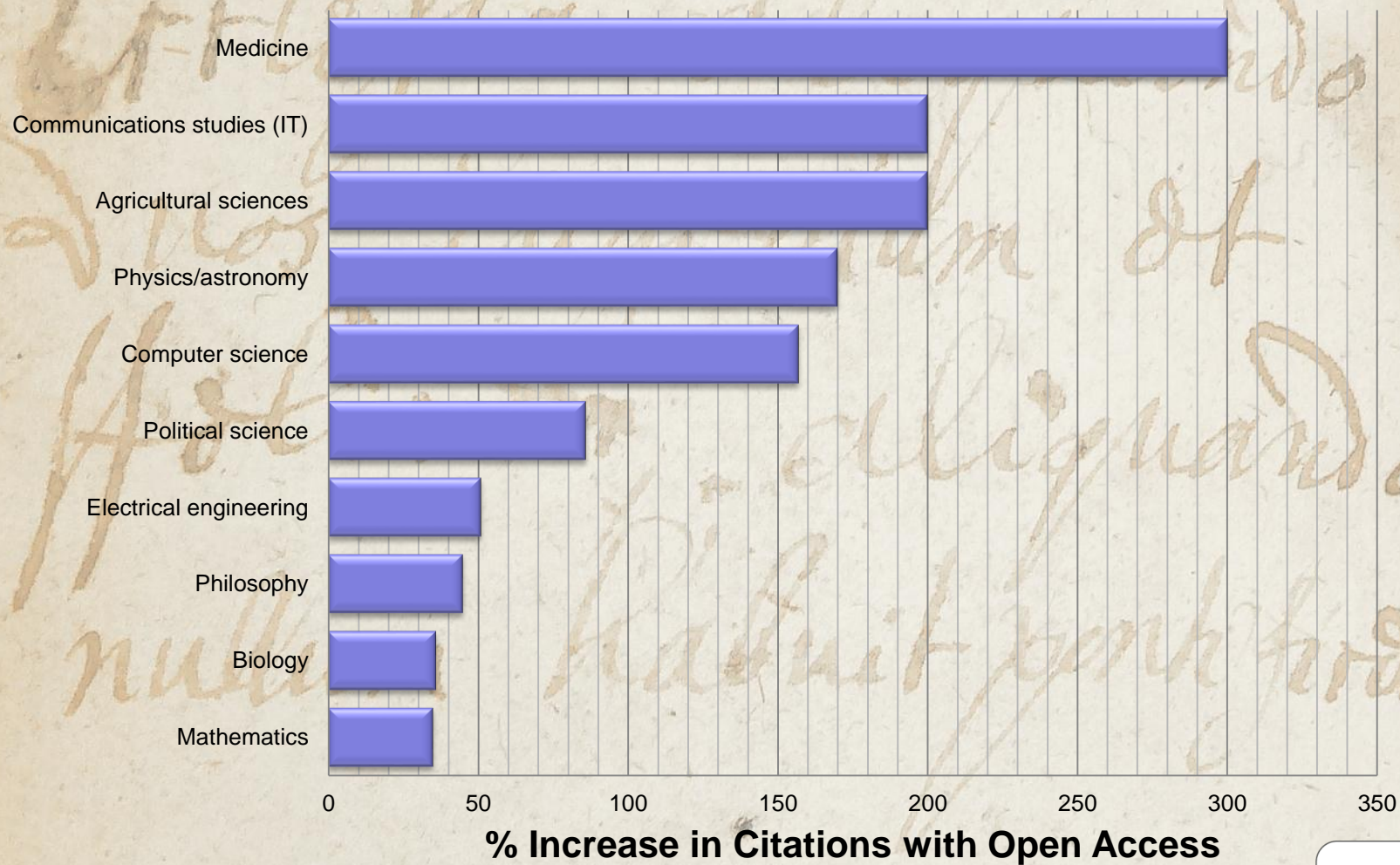

- What else?

Preservation	All publications in one place, forever. UL knows what it produces.
Access	The author controls the level of access ; Easy to respond to requests for article copies; Statistics on views and downloads.
Reusable	Generate CV; Link from webpage: Publications for Pascale Engel de Abreu On external websites : Innovation Portal
Ownership	The author is the owner of their publications; The author is responsible for entry into ORBi ^{lu}
