LCGR project in four points

- What: Creation of an online course in French and German declined in 6 versions (one per language center) + two retreats
- **To whom**: Students of the Great Region's universities motivated by an exchange within the GR.
- Why: To help them preparing their exchange linguistically and culturally
- When: Winter semester 2018 for the online course.



+ LCGR project goals

Creation of a common tool for languages teaching (German and French) => an online course

- Promoting language learning through cross-border cooperation

- Improving language, intercultural and learning skills of students

- Enhancing digital integration in language teaching; developping new approaches to teaching and learning; promoting personalised and flexible learning pathways.
- Boosting the employability of graduates by raising awareness of language skill needs

- Erasmus students who wanted to follow the course of the university where they are doing their mobility






LCGR CourseFor the future
